

- lack of connection to others








Acupressure points for anxiety may offer relief, including areas on the hands and face

Relieves stress, insomnia, body aches, headaches


















CVS in recent years has strived to make their product models more sustainable by "going green" and reducing waste

Eliminated 500,000 empty miles through the backhaul program so our trucks never travel without purpose






Plant based non-GMO products

Don't take a bag, or bring your own reusable bag Recycle prescription bottles








Improving the current position: we believe CVS could use more recycled and repurposed materials to further the "greener" goal. There is ample used-material around the globe that should be utilized more efficiently. These materials are already machined, in essence, and it would take far less energy and money to repurpose materials rather than generating virgin ones.







By using recycled rubber for the body of the design, we can repurpose waste to ensure a greener future.

The refillable application cartridge will also reduce the need for multiple components being produced in the long run.

The instruction guide associated with the product is also paperless as it is in app form. This reduces packaging materials and waste from paper use.

While it is technically a natural material, we understand the production of rubber can be very harmful to the environment, so we are going to use recycled, preexisting, rubber. Recycling rubber uses less energy than creating new synthetic rubber and it reduces the need to harvest more natural rubber.
